

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What is the current wait time for a bow build?

A: The current wait time depends on the waiting list and your build request. You can call to find out the current wait time prior to any order.

Q: What arrows can I use in my bow?

A: You can shoot carbon, aluminum and wood arrows which are properly spined for your bow. Ensure that you have a minimum of 8 grains per pound of draw weight. I recommend 10-12 grains per pound of draw weight.

Q: Do you require a deposit when I place my bow build order?

A: No, a minimum deposit payment of 25% is required at the time I make contact with you when your bow is next on the build list. I will call to verify your build prior to starting.

Q: What poundage do you recommend?

A: I recommend your draw weight be that which is comfortable to shoot. Some say that if you currently shoot a compound, 20-25% less of your total compound draw weight is comfortable.

Q: Can I change my order after it is sent?

A: The length, wood type, and poundage should be established prior to sending the order. Some minor changes can be made throughout the build; however, it will depend on the stage at which the build is in.
